1945	❖ Moved to Britain ❖ Schooling at various schools near London, with my last year at a public school - Merchant Tailors <i>Undistinguished student except for 1st prize in school debate on the subject "Teaching of Latin Should Be Prohibited"</i>
1954	❖ Moved to Canada <i>Attended Lower Canada College in Montreal</i>
1957	❖ Attended McGill and obtained B.Sc., primarily in Mathematics and Physics
1966	❖ Obtained LL.B. at Dalhousie, Halifax
1967	❖ Articled with Farris & Company <i>Principals were David Vaughan and Jack Taggart, QC</i>
1968-71	❖ Associate with Gotham and Volrich
1971-97	❖ Private practice as sole practitioner in various locations in downtown Vancouver
1985	❖ Founded Salvation Army Pro Bono Program
1990	❖ Founded "Start" (the Lower Mainland Society to Assist Research of Trials, which later became Access Justice)
1997	❖ Worked for approximately one year for the Central Coordinator of the Salvation Army (approximately 25 clinics and 250 lawyers when I left) ❖ Changed "Start"'s name to The Western Society to Access Justice
